# **Disability access**

We would love to host you with your accessibility challenges but I would however point out that the drive is gravel and very difficult for wheelchairs and anyone who is not sure of their footing. There are steps into the shepherd hut. The patios is made of sleepers and is not even and can be very slippery when wet. The decking around the hot tub can also get slippery when wet. The property is on a single level once through the front door. There are no grab rails in the bathroom or kitchen. If you have accessibility challenges I suggest that you call me before booking this property.

#### **Directions**

Please arrive anytime after 16.00. Check-out time is 10.00 firm.

Here are the directions you will need:

- The Postcode is IP24 2SB
- Quavers Rest is situated just off the village green in Rushford
- You will need to get the village green on your left. Parked beside the village sign your SatNav will tell you that Quavers Rest is the house on the right. It is a lie!
- We are the next house on the LEFT twenty yards past the village sign
- Look for the 30 mph sign, long conifer hedge, gravel drive and two HUGE flower pots. You will find Quavers Rest on the left-hand side of the drive







### **Parking**

There is parking for one car but if you have two cars please leave one vehicle on the road. Please park between the sleepers, it is a bit tight but it works. Please do NOT park on the village green as it will get me into trouble
